

# AGENCIES OF THE EUROPEAN UNION




- ➤ EU agencies are distinct bodies from the EU institutions – separate legal entities set up to perform specific tasks under EU law.
- > There are more than 40 agencies,
- Decentralised agencies carry out technical, scientific, administrative or managerial tasks that help the EU institutions make and implement policies.
- They also support cooperation between the EU and national governments by pooling technical and specialist expertise from both the EU institutions and national authorities. Decentralised agencies are set up for an indefinite period and are located across the EU.



#### EUROPEAN UNION INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY OFFICE

- EUIPO is one of the largest EU agency in terms of budget and staff and has full legal and financial autonomy.
- ☐ Since the office's opening, its core business has been the registration of trade marks and later designs.
- □ 5 working languages: English, French, German, Italian and Spanish.

The EUIPO has been headed by **João Negrão**, since 2023, a Portuguese national.


# **CORE ACTIVITIES**



#### **EUTM** and RCD registration

Managing EU Trade Marks and Registered Community Designs

- Total number of Trade Mark applications: > 2.46 million (December 2021)
- Total number of Designs applications: 1.53 million (December 2021)
- 99% of Trade Mark applications filed online





- •The basic fee covers one class for EUR 850.
- •The fee for the second class of goods and services is EUR 50.
- •The fee for three or more classes is EUR 150 for each class
